



Lower Camp Rules and Regulations

Anyone over the age of 17 is required to have a current Police record check w/vulnerable sector screening. Send copy to the OCM office with deposit.

Guests must check in with the Camp Directors upon arrival.
Vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas.

No person under the age of 21 is permitted to rent the cabins.
Parents are responsible for the supervision of their children at all times.

Swimming and water activities are at your own risk.

Canoes/kayaks are to be signed out under the supervision of the Camp waterfront coordinator. Life jackets must be worn at all times while using camp watercraft. Children under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.

Camp quiet time is 11pm-8am daily.

Campfires are permitted only in the approved fire pit and are subject to camp guidelines and regional district regulations. (An adult must be present at all campfires, a bucket of water must be kept nearby within reach, the fire must be completely extinguished before leaving the campfire area.)

Camp Directors have the right to refuse anyone admission and/or evict anyone who defaults in payment, causes a disturbance, does not comply with camp policy, rules, regulations, the law, or who willingly destroys personal or camp property.

The lower camp is open from June 22 – Aug 23; Aug 31-Sept 13

There is no laundry service available on site.

Garbage collection is your responsibility; receptacles provided.
